ACCESSIBILITY

In 2015, the FCM hosted five Free Access Days, sponsored by supporting organizations like Kohl's & Hurley, Belill Eye Care, Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, Greater Flint Association for the Education of Young Children, Genesee Health System, and Brown & Brown

Through these partnerships, we were able to provide free access to 3,267 visitors!

Monthly \$2 Tuesdays made the Museum more affordable for lower-income families last year, and next year, we will be partnering with the Association of Children's Museum to offer "Museums For All"—an even more expansive program that provides 50% off admission every day for qualifying visitors. Marking our second year of partnership with the Flint Farmer's Market, we also remain committed to providing an admission-free satellite location to all Market visitors.

PROGRAMMING

This year, we remained committed to providing engaging hands-on programming, and focused even more closely on activities related to STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) and Next Generation Science Standards. 
The many meaningful partnerships that we have with volunteers is crucial to our mission of serving children and families. Thank you to all who work with us!


